- 3. NSFR was implemented effective from 30 June 2024, and the minimum regulatory requirement as from 30 June 2024 is 70%. As from 31 December 2024, the minimum regulatory requirement will be 100%.

Comments:

- As at 30 June 2024, the NSFR was at 174% above the minimum regulatory requirement of 70%.
- The amount of available stable funding (ASF) was measured based on the broad characteristics of
 the relative stability of the bank's funding sources, including the contractual maturity of its liabilities
 and the differences in the propensity of different types of funding providers to withdraw their
 funding.
- The amount of required stable funding (RSF) was measured based on the broad characteristics of the liquidity risk profile of the bank's assets and off-balance sheet exposures.
